

# Exodus 32-35

The Golden Calf, Judgment and Restoration of a Renewed  
Covenant

## Ex 32

- The peoples' tragic turn to idolatry
- Aaron's complicity- builds the calf
- Moses' intercession

## Ex 33

- God remains faithful to His covenant
  - Entry into the promised land is still going to happen- however, God's presence on the way is withdrawn
- Tent of meeting to be outside the camp
- Moses' request- for God's presence and God's glory
- God's response- "My glory is My goodness"

## Ex 34

- God's sermon on His Name- "Yahweh, Yahweh God, compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness and truth; who keeps lovingkindness for thousands, who forgives iniquity, transgression, and sin; yet He will by no means leave *the guilty* unpunished, visiting the iniquity of fathers on the children and on the grandchildren to the third and fourth generations."
- A.W Tozer- "Grace is the good pleasure of God that inclines Him to bestow benefits upon the undeserving. It is a self-existent principle inherent in the divine nature and appears to us as a self-caused propensity to pity the wretched, spare the guilty, welcome the outcast, and bring into favor those who were before under just disapprobation. Its use to us sinful men is to save us and make us sit together in heavenly places to demonstrate to the ages the exceeding riches of God's kindness to us in Christ Jesus".
