Genesis 37: Joseph sold into slavery

- a. Joseph, the beloved of his father, hated by his brothers (v. 1-17)**
- b. The evil plan of Joseph's brothers to get rid of him (v.18-28)**
- c. Joseph's sold by his brothers and Joseph's apparent death to Jacob (v.25-36)**

Genesis 38: Judah and Tamar

a. Judah and his family (v.1-5)

b. The wickedness and death of Er and Onan, sons of Judah (v.6-11)

c. Tamar's deceitful plan to conceive (v.12-23)

d. Judah hypocrisy (v.24-30)

Genesis 39: God's presence with Joseph in his affliction

- a. The Lord's presence with Joseph and His blessing through Joseph to Potiphar (v.1-6a)**
- b. Joseph's God-consciousness and reverent fear of God (6b-18)**
- c. Joseph's unjust imprisonment (v.19-23)**

Genesis 40: Joseph interprets the dreams of Pharaoh's officials

a. The imprisonment of the king's officers (v.1-4)

b. The dreams of the king's officers and the interpretations of their dreams (v.5-23)

Genesis 41 Pharaoh's dream and Joseph's exaltation

a. Pharaoh's dream (v.1-8)

b. Pharaoh's cupbearer remembers Joseph (v. 9-13)

c. Pharaoh calls Joseph for the interpretation of his dream (v.14-24)

d. Joseph interprets Pharaoh's dream (v.25-36).

e. Joseph's exaltation and stewardship in the years of abundance and famine (v.37-57)
